YES, we look forward to this great day every year. Would YOU join in with us this time?

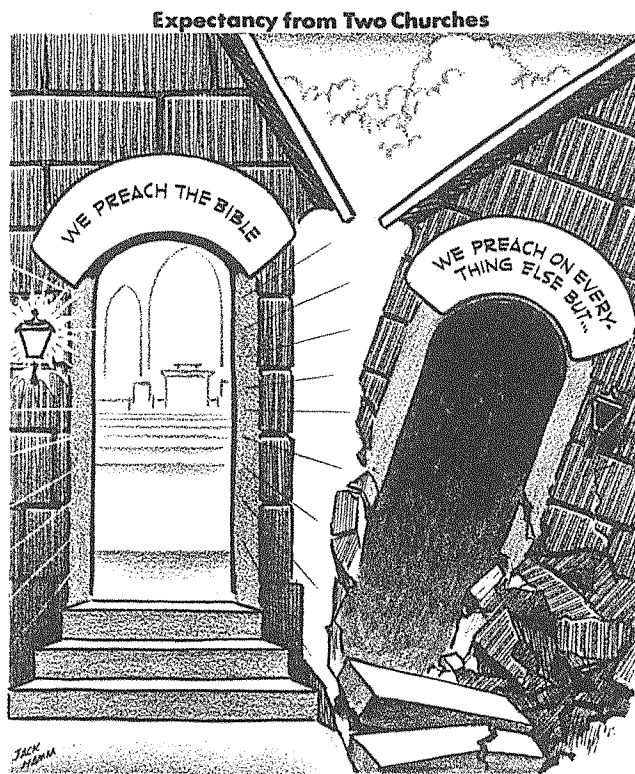

Patience produces unity in the Church, loyalty in the State, harmony in families and societies; she comforts the poor, and moderates the rich; she makes us humble in prosperity, cheerful in adversity, unmoved by calumny and reproach; she teaches us to forgive those who have injured us, and to be the first in asking forgiveness of those whom we have injured; she delights the faithful and invites the unbelieving; she adorns the woman and approves the man; she is beautiful in either sex and every age. Behold her appearance and her attire. Her countenance is calm and serene as the face of heaven unspotted by the shadow of a cloud, and no wrinkle of grief or anger is seen on her forehead. Her eyes are as the eyes of doves for meekness, and on her eyebrows sit cheerfulness and joy. Her mouth is lovely in silence; her complexion and colour that of innocence and security; while, like the virgin, the daughter of Zion, she shakes her head at the adversary, despising and laughing him to scorn. She is clothed in the robes of the martyrs, and in her hands she holds a sceptre in the form of a cross. She rides not in the whirlwind and stormy tempest of passion, but her throne is the humble and contrite heart, and her kingdom is the kingdom of peace.—*Bishop Horne.*

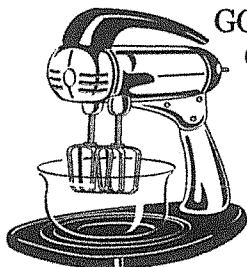

**'SENSUOUS' CHRISTIANS - "living by feelings"**

"... *sensuous* people live by their feelings rather than through their *understanding*. Sadly, this kind of sensuality has also wormed its way into the church. Many of us have become *sensuous Christians*, living by our feelings rather than through our understanding of the Word of God. Sensuous Christians cannot be moved to service, prayer or study unless they *feel like it*'.

Their Christian life is only as effective as the intensity of present feelings. When they experience spiritual euphoria, they are a whirlwind of godly activity; when they are depressed, they are a spiritual incompetent. They constantly seek new and fresh spiritual experiences, and use them to determine the Word of God. Their 'inner feelings' become the ultimate test of truth. Sensuous Christians don't need to study the Word of God because they already know the will of God by their feelings.

They don't want to *know* God; they want to *experience* Him. Sensuous Christians go their merry way until they encounter the pain of life that is not so merry - and they fold ...

The Bible is addressed primarily, though not exclusively, to our understanding.

**Why are you So Fearful?**

Matthew 8:23 - 27

- **Fear of Failure** - Not being successful by the world's standards. In the end, only God decides who is a success or a failure and He bases His decision on our relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ.
- **Fear of Rejection** - Not being "accepted" and "approved" by the world. If you're a Christian and live to please God, the world will reject you.
- **Fear of the Unknown** - Not able to live by faith. Not being able to trust God in things outside of your control. The Bible reminds us that *"the just shall live by faith"* (Hebrews 10:38). And *"without faith it is impossible to please him (God)"* (Hebrews 11:6).
- **Fear of Death** - A failure to fulfill all carnal desires. Sin is never satisfied. Death should hold no fear for the Christian. In I Corinthians 15:54 we read *"Death is swallowed up in victory."*
- **Fear of Disease** - Destruction of our flesh. Our flesh was never redeemed and will return to the dust. A Christian should look forward with great anticipation to the "blessed hope" of receiving a new body which can not be affected by disease or death.
- **Fear of Detection** - *"Letting down your guard"* and revealing to others who you really are. The Bible is the most loved and yet the most hated book ever written because it reveals the truth about man. As a Christian, I know that I'm accepted by God and I don't have to try to be somebody or something I'm not.
- **Fear of Desolation** - Loneliness, forsaken and forgotten by friends and family. A Christian may become lonely but he is never alone or forsaken. God promises the believer in Hebrews 13:5: *"I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee."*
