# "Ye must be born again" Pt II

What being 'Born Again' is NOT –

It's NOT RELIGION, relying on church membership and attendance is one of the most deceptive counterfeits of being 'born again'; it's NOT PERSONAL MORALITY or doing good - absolute perfection is God's requirement and no one is without guilt when you consider your words, actions, and even thoughts must be sinless; it's NOT SUPERFICIALLY BELIEVING in Jesus Christ – the Bible definition of *believing* is very different from the

intellectual-only definition generally understood; it's NOT REFORMATION - the New Birth is an actual birth, a *spiritual birth*, not just changing to be a better person; it's NOT A FAMILY faith or tradition — no one is a Christian because their parents were or because they went to church with their family.

✓ There is only ONE WAY to be 'born again', by receiving Jesus Christ as Lord! Romans 6:23, 10:13

## SANCTIFICATION

"For this is the will of God, even your sanctification ... And the very God of peace sanctify you wholly; and I pray God your whole spirit and soul and body be preserved blameless unto the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ."

- I Thessalonians 4:3,4; 5:23,

"To illustrate, suppose you built a fence all around your property.

You would be distinguishing your property from your neighbor's property. You would be marking it off and setting boundaries to it. This is exactly what sanctification does in a Christian's life.

God separates us from the world. ('PROPERTY OF GOD')

He marks us with certain boundary markers so that it is easy to see we are different. If a believer does not separate himself from the world, then he will appear to be the same as the world.

When God tells us to 'be ye separate', He means that there should be marked differences in us, so that it will be obvious that we are believers.

This is SANCTIFICATION.





## MORALITY NEEDED




