

There is much need of calling attention to this truth at the present day. The age is a luxurious one; ease and comfort seem to be the ends of life.

This spirit is creeping into our churches. It is difficult to get people to realize their responsibility, and to work for God. They gauge everything by the amount of

They gauge everything by the amount of pleasure it gives, and not by the good it is calculated to do them. Men ought to have a higher ideal. God saves us that we might be His fellow-workers. God makes us soldiers before He makes us saints. The highest test of religion is not enjoyment, but usefulness! There is joy in religion. It is the most joyous thing in the world; but then the joy is associated with work. There is no real pleasure in idleness. It is the working man, and not the skulking idler, that has the most physical enjoyment. So in spiritual things. There is no luxury like that of doing good. If any Christian lacks joy ... let him work more for God. He expects us all to be workers.



Renounces the Prosperity 'Gospel'
"Growing up in the Hinn family empire was like
belonging to some hybrid of the royal family and
the mafia. Our lifestyle was lavish, our loyalty
was enforced, and our version of the gospel
was big business. Though Jesus Christ was still a
part of our gospel, he was more of a magic genie
than the King of Kings. Rubbing him the right
way—by giving money and having enough faith

—would unlock your spiritual inheritance. God's goal was not his glory but our gain. His grace was not to set us free from sin but to make us rich. The abundant life he offered wasn't eternal, it was now. We lived the prosperity gospel. ... We lived in a 10,000-square-foot mansion guarded by a private gate, drove two Mercedes Benz vehicles, vacationed in exotic destinations, and shopped at the most expensive stores. On top of that, we bought a \$2 million ocean-view home in Dana Point, California, where another Benz joined

the fleet. ... doubts would surface.

What about unsuccessful healing attempts?

I learned that it was the sick person's fault for doubting God. Why would we speak in tongues without interpretation? 'Don't quench the Spirit,'

I was told. 'He can do what he wants.'

Why did many of our prophecies contradict the Bible? 'Don't put God in a box.' Despite the questions, I trusted my family because we were so successful. ... After graduating college and returning home, I met my wife, Christyne. I had no idea that God would use her in bringing about my salvation. In fact, my family and I were nervous because she didn't speak in tongues. ... one day she pointed to a verse I had never seen: 1 Corinthians 12:30 'Do all have gifts of healing? Do all speak in tongues? Do all interpret?'). I was shaken to the core.
