Christian's Fears


"I have noticed in recent years

In using the world's genres of music, it blurs the gap between worldly Satanic values and divine ones. It tends to deny the power of the simple gospel and the sovereign saving work of the Holy Spirit. It creates a wide generation gap in the church, thus contributing to the disunity and lack of intimacy in the fellowship of all believers. It leads to the propagation of bad or weak theology and drags the name of the Lord down to the level of the world. The music of the gospel is certainly not to be a means for making money or seeking fame, and it must never be allowed to cheapen what is priceless, or trivialize what is profound." -The MacArthur New Testament

'shamefacedness' — I Timothy 2:9

"In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety" "Shamefacedness' is from the Greek aidos, which meaning godly humility. It 'has the idea of downcast eyes' and means 'bashfulness, i.e. (towards men), modesty or (towards God) awe', (Strong). It implies 'a shrinking from trespassing the boundaries of propriety' (William Hendrickson, N. T. Commentary). Shamefacedness is shyness in the sense of humility, submission to God, submission to God's will,

submission to God's order of creation. Shamefacedness is that 'meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price' (I Peter 3:3-4). The shamefaced woman loves God and is committed to obeying His Word, and this is reflected on her face and in every aspect of her life, including her clothing. It is a renunciation of 'the pride of life' which is a major characteristic of this fallen world (IJohn 2:16). A shamefaced Christian woman will not have the attitude that says, 'Don't tell me how to dress; I will dress as I please!' She will not be stubborn and sassy. She will not say, 'I don't care what some old-fashioned men say about how I dress; that is their problem; I'm not going to be a weirdo! That is exactly the spirit of this lost world, and the fact that so many women in 'Bible-believing' churches reflect that spirit is clear evidence of apostasy. Paul described apostasy as a Christianity that lives according to its own lusts (II Timothy 4:3-4). Shamefacedness is exactly the opposite of the cheeky, saucy, proud, impertinent, brash, flippant, sensual, show yourself off, insubordinate attitude that the world seeks to develop in women today and that is modeled by Hollywood starlets and rock & roll queens. " - copied
