ARGUMENT Against ATHEISM

"On of the strongest arguments by Christians against atheism is that atheism provides no foundation for decent and moral living. If God does not exist, then no final authority exists which can arbitrate

between right and wrong.

Additionally there is no final judgment facing those who do evil. In the light of these ideas Christians often assume that atheists will ultimately and consistently live out the conclusions of their beliefs - resulting in nihilism ('nihilism' - "the denial of the existence of any basis for knowledge or truth; the doctrine that all social, political, and economic institutions must be completely destroyed in order to make way for new institutions) and anarchy ... 'How do we define 'good' if we don't believe in God? If we are each ourselves defining what's 'good',

it's going to be a crazy world ... Nietzsche knew, however, that with the loss of an absolute would come nihilism and despair. Without God where would humans find their reason to live, their purpose, their foundation for morals and values?"


The 'Good Cause

The "LORD"

"The angelic declaration sums up the person of our Redeemer,

"A SAVIOUR, which is CHRIST THE LORD." Luke 2:11

In the New Testament the word Saviour occurs twenty-four times, eight of which refer to God the Father as our Saviour. The word Lord occurs five hundred and twenty eight times, Lord Jesus thirty times, and the Lord Jesus Christ eighty-one times. In the book of The Acts our precious Redeemer is called Saviour only twice, "Him hath God exalted ... to be a Prince and a Saviour." Acts 5:31; and, "Of this man's seed hath God according to his promise raised unto Israel a Saviour, Jesus." Acts 13:23.

On the other hand it is amazing to notice that the title "Lord" is mentioned ninety-two times; "Lord Jesus" thirteen times; and the "Lord Jesus Christ" six times, in the same book. "Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord Christ.", Acts 2:32-36.

We note that the emphasis is not so much on ... His Saviourhood as on his Lordship."

Repentance Necessary "Repentance is not arbitrary. It is not left

to our choice whether or not we will repent, but it is an indispensable command. God has enacted a law in the High Court of heaven that no sinner shall be saved except the repenting sinner ... Though all the angels should stand before God and beg the life of an un-repenting person, God would not grant it. The LORD God, merciful and gracious,

... Keeping mercy for thousands, ... and that by no means clear the guilty.' (Exodus 34:6-7). Though God is more full of mercy than the sun is of light: 'He will by no means clear the guilty!' Till a sinner repents, God and he cannot be friends: "what communion hath light with darkness?" (II Corinthians 6:14). How can the righteous God indulge him that goes on still in his trespasses? "I will not justify the wicked" (Exodus 23:7).

If God should be at peace with a sinner before he repents, God would seem to like and approve of all that he has done. He would go against His own Holiness. It is inconsistent with the sanctity of God's nature to pardon a sinner while he is in the act of rebellion. ... If God should save men without repentance, making no discrimination, then by this rule He must save all, not only men, but devils ... " - Thomas Watson,



PONY EXPRESS

The Pony Express was a thrilling part of early American history. It ran from St. Joseph, Missouri, to Sacramento, California - a distance of

1,900 miles. The trip was made in ten days. Forty men, each riding 50 miles a day, dashed along the trail on 500 of the best horses the West could provide. To conserve weight, clothing was very light, saddles were extremely small and thin, and no weapons were carried. The horses wore small shoes or none at all. The mail pouches were flat and very conservative in size. Letters had to be written on thin paper, and postage was \$5 an ounce (a tremendous sum those days). Yet, each rider carried a full-sized Bible!"
