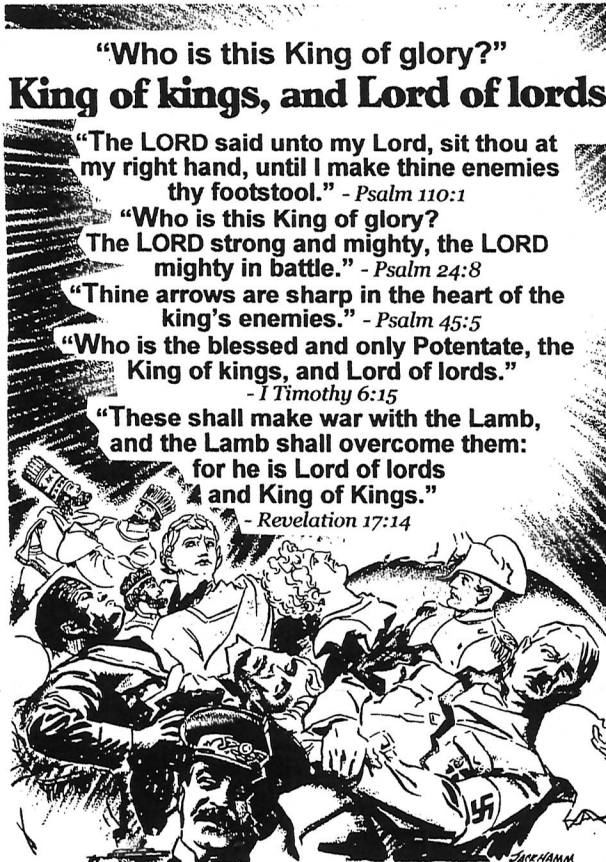

When God has sent his ministers one after another, exhorting and persuading men to leave their sins, but they settle upon the 'lees' of formality and can sit and sleep under a sermon, it will be hard for these ever to be brought to repentance.
- (2) Those who have sinned frequently against the convictions of the word, the check of conscience, and the motions of the Spirit. It is one thing to sin for lack of light and another thing to sin against light. Men begin by sinning against the light of conscience, and proceed gradually to 'despising' ('showing contempt or scorn for; also, provoking to anger') the Spirit of grace." - Thomas Watson, 'The Doctrine of Repentance', p 60-61

ARE YOU GOING TO HEAVEN?

The most important question you will ever answer is: Where will you spend eternity, in heaven or in hell? The Bible, God's Holy Word, is the only book that can show you the way to heaven.

The Bible says, "...there is none that doeth good, no, not one" (Romans 3:12) and, "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God" (Romans 3:23). You must admit that you are a sinner.

The Bible says the penalty for your sin is death in hell. "For the wages of sin is death..." (Romans 6:23). This is the eternal, spiritual death warned of in Revelation 20:14: "And death and hell were cast into the lake of fire. This is the second death."

However, Jesus Christ, who is God, loved you enough to suffer your hell by shedding his blood on the cross. The Bible says, "But God commendeth his love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us" (Romans 5:8). The Son of God paid the penalty for your sin.

According to God's Word, you cannot go to heaven by doing good works. The Bible says, "For by grace are ye saved through faith...Not of works, lest any man should boast" (Ephesians 2:8, 9). As a sinner, there is no good work that you can do to merit heaven.

In order to avoid hell and go to heaven you must:

1. Repent of your sin. This means more than feeling sorry for sin. It means feeling sorry enough to quit and actually turn from your sin (Luke 13:3).

2. Put your faith in Christ. Romans 10:9 says "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved." You must accept Christ as Lord, believing that He died for you and rose again. Jesus Christ is the only way to heaven. He said, "I am the way, the truth, and the life; no man cometh unto the Father, but by me" (John 14:6).

Two Kinds of 'Love'

"One of the puzzling questions likely to turn up sooner or later to vex the seeking Christian is how to fulfill the Scriptural command to 'love God with all his heart and his neighbor as himself'. He wants to, but he cannot. The delightful wells of feeling simply will not flow.

How can I love by commandment? To find our way out of the shadows and into the cheerful sunlight we need only to know that there are *two kinds of love*: the love of (based on) *feeling* and the love of (based on) *willing*.

The one lies in the 'emotions'; the other in the 'will'. The love the Bible enjoins is *not* the love of *feeling*; it is the love of *willing*, the willing tendency of the heart.

The *will*, not the *feelings*, determines moral direction. The root of all evil in human nature is the corruption of the *will*. The prodigal son took his first step upward from the pigsty when he said, 'I *will* arise and go to my father.

As he once *willed* to leave his father's house, now he *willed* to return. To love God with all our heart, we must first of all *will* to do so." - A. W. Tozer

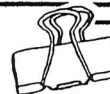
