HOW TO VOTE AS A CHRISTIAN

"There is something worse than
not voting, and that is
casting an ignorant vote."

WHAT IS AN IGNORANT VOTE?
A Christian should *not* vote a 'party',
or a personality, and especially *not*
cast an ignorant vote!

To vote as a Christian is to first
learn what the Bible says - 'search
the Scriptures' - Acts 17:11- to find out
what God says about issues and people!

1. Voting on an issue or person,
without knowing what God's Word
says about it is
casting an ignorant vote.
2. Know the candidate and where
he/she stands on the issues -
know their history, how they've
voted and served in the past.
3. Know who their political 'friends'
are - "Blessed is the man that
walketh not in the counsel
of the ungodly ...", - Psalm 1:1
4. An ignorant vote is voting without
knowing how your Pastor is going
to vote. "... whose faith follow ...",
Hebrews 13:7
5. To Vote contrary to and in oppo-
sition of what the Bible teaches,
is to cast a vote against God and
His Word. (Jesus said,
"He that is not with me is against me:
and he that gathereth not with me
scattereth.", Luke 11:23);
there's no middle ground here;
to vote for or against the Bible
is to vote for or against Christ!

WITCHCRAFT AND THE MODERN WORLD

"The modern world is permeated with witchcraft.

Since the 1960s, rock music has promoted pagan and demonic themes. The Rolling Stones, for example, sang 'Sympathy for the Devil' and incorporated voodoo ceremonies into their Goat's Head Soup album.

Hinduism and its popular western counterpart, the New Age, are demonic to the core.

The cover story of Time magazine for June 19, 1972, was 'Occult Revival.' It described a growing fascination with witchcraft among college educated people. Ancient occult practices such as Tarot, I Ching, palmistry, and Ouija boards have exploded in popularity. In 1969, Anton LaVey published The Satanic Bible, which has gone through dozens of printings and has been translated into Spanish, Danish, and Swedish. The occult is a major theme in popular writing. Even the most mainstream bookstores have sections on the occult and the paranormal. The Harry Potter books, which promote unadulterated witchcraft to children, have sold 450 million copies, and the Harry Potter franchise, which includes the movies, has brought in \$24 billion in sales. Science Fiction is filled with occult themes. Hollywood has spewed out occult movies one after the other, such as Rosemary's Baby, The Exorcist, The Omen, Star Wars (promoting the occult concept of 'the Force'), Avatar, Lord of the Rings, The Matrix, and Blair Witch. New Dawn Magazine for March 21, 2014, reported that 'Russia is currently undergoing a massive occult revival.' Nearly 40% of books in Russian deal with the occult, and popular TV programs promote the paranormal. Astrology, which was born in ancient Babylon, has witnessed an explosion in popularity in modern times. Newspapers carry horoscopes, and Americans purchase 20 million books on astrology annually."

The 'Spirit' of the 'World'

"The Christian is called to separation from the world, but we must be sure we know what we mean (or more important what God means) by the 'world'. We are likely to make it mean something external only and thus miss its real meaning. The theatre, cards, liquor, gambling - these are not the 'world'; they are merely an external manifestation of the 'world'.

Our warfare is not against merely an external manifestation of the 'world'. Our warfare is not against mere worldly ways, but against the 'spirit' of the 'world'. For man, whether he is saved or lost, is essentially spirit.

The 'world' in the New Testament meaning of the word, is simply unregenerate human nature wherever it is found, whether in a tavern or in a church. Whatever springs out of, is built upon, or receives support from, fallen human nature, is the 'world', whether it is morally based or morally respectable." - A.W. Tozer, 'Culture',
