

"Ye Must be Born Again", John 3:7 - John Wesley (1703-1791)

"But, although man was made in the image of God, yet he was not made immutable ('unchangeable') This would have been inconsistent with the state of trial in which God was pleased to place him. He was therefore created able to stand, and yet liable to fall. And this God Himself apprised him of, and gave him a solemn warning against it. Nevertheless, man did not abide in honor; he fell from his high estate. He ate of the tree whereof the Lord had commanded him, *Thou shouldest* not eat?". By this willful act of disobedience to his Creator, this fiat rebellion against his Sovereign, he openly declared that the would no longer have God to rule over him; that he would be governed by his own will, and not the will of Him that created him; and that he would not seek his happiness in God, but in the world, in the works of his hands. Now, God had told him before, for in the day that thou eatest thereof thou shalt surely die." And the Word of the Lord cannot be broken.

Accordingly, in that day he did die - He died to God - the most dreadful of all deaths.

He lost the life of God; he was separated from Him, ... The body dies when it is separated from God. But this separation from God, Adam ... gave immediate

proof; presently showing by his behavior, that the love of God was extinguished in his soul, which was now 'alienated from the life of God' (Ephesians 4:18). Instead of this, he was now under the power of servile

fear, so that he fled from the presence of the Lord. Yea, so little did he retain even of the knowledge of Him who filleth heaven and earth, that he endeavored to hide himself *from the presence of the Lord God amongst the trees of the garden.*" (Genesis 3:8). So he had lost both the knowledge and the love of God, without which the

image of God could not subsist ('continue to live'). Of this, therefore, he was deprived at the same time,

and became unholy as well as unhappy. In the room of this, he had sunk into (1) pride and

self-will, the very image of the devil; and (2) into sensual appetites and desires, the image of the beasts that perish."
