#### A Presbyterian's Break with Calvinism

"Albert Barnes" was a Presbyterian theologian who broke from strict Calvinism and taught that man had free will to accept or deny the Gospel. His views brought him into serious conflict with strict Calvinists. Barnes was charged with doctrinal heresy after the publication of his commentary on Romans, but was ultimately acquitted by the church's general assemble, though with some censure.

His teaching on 'unlimited atonement (contrary to Calvin) helped generate a split in the Presbyterian Church in 1837. Barnes was officially accused of heresy for his 'New School' views on human ability, imputation, and atonement." (copied)
