

THE 'NEW BIRTH' John 3:1-12

A. The 'New Birth' exposes the insufficiency of 'religion' (Christian 'religion' or others). Jesus preached the new birth to show this self-righteous-minded man that 'religion' and the works of the law are entirely insufficient to 'save' a man (from the guilt of personal sins).

B. The 'New Birth' points to the cross, where Jesus died in the sinner's place and was raised from the dead to new life.

The 'New Birth' is a 'spiritual' birth in contrast to the natural birth, v 5-6.

D. The 'New Birth' is universally necessary - all people must be 'Born Again' ('ye' is plural).

E. The 'New Birth' is universally available, v 16 (see I Timothy 2:3-6).

F. The "New Birth' is for those who are already condemned, v 18; 'all have sinned'

G. The 'New Birth' is the work of God the Holy Spirit, v 8

H. The 'New Birth' can be seen, v 8, (II Corinthians 5:17, 'behold').

There is evidence as we see in every example of salvation recorded in the New Testament!


Keys to Spiritual Victory

"When the believer comes to Christ, God regenerates him and gives him a holy nature, but the old sin nature is still present.

the old man and putting on the new; not grieving the Holy Spirit, 4:30; having no fellowship with evil, 5:11; walking circumspectly, 5:15;



redeeming the time, 5:16; being filled with the Spirit, 5:18; giving thanks to the Lord, 5:20; wives submitting to their husbands and husbands loving their wives, 5:22-33; putting on the whole armor of God, 6:10-18."
