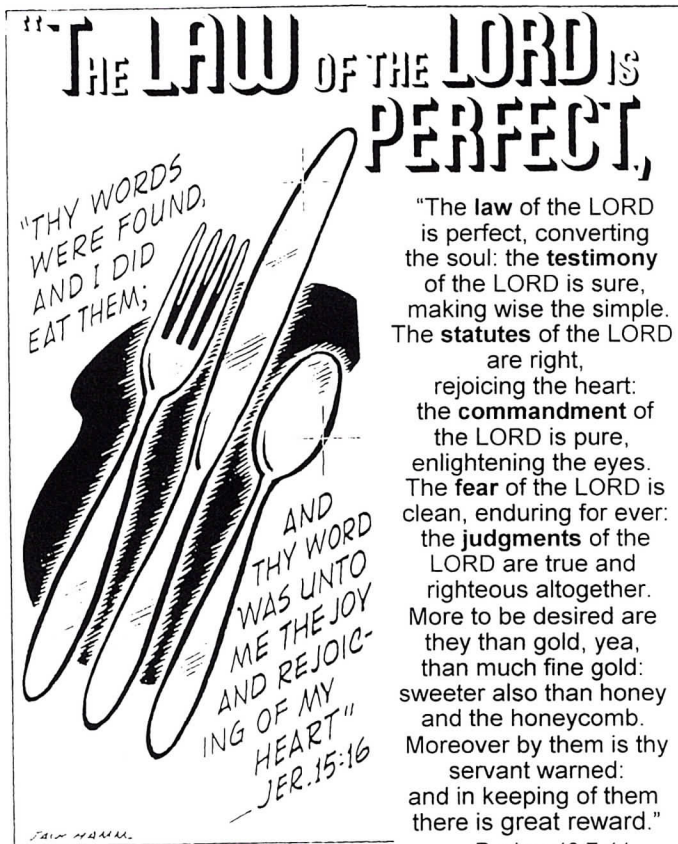

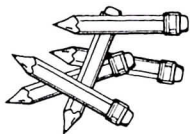

Government Extremes
